Shingler v. Houle Victoria, BC - November, 21, 2008 Justice D. M. Masuhara Presiding

(Irrelevant, distinctly unhelpful, lacking in objectivity, and merely inflammatory)

"Much of the evidence I heard was largely irrelevant to the real issues, and some was distinctly unhelpful.

The evidence of Mr. Madera was particularly lacking in objectivity and was, at times, merely inflammatory."

Madera v. Law Society Supreme Court, BC - June 3, 19993 Hon. Justices; Hutcheon, Goldie, and Chief Justice McEachern Presiding

(Lying, a general lack of credibility, and conduct ultimately eliminating him as a candidate for the Law Society)

"The Applicant says that it is unfair because he has not had an opportunity at the time he is being compelled to give evidence to know, to hear in evidence what 'his accusers', in his words, have to say. I cannot accede to that submission. Very full and complete particulars including the names of witnesses were given and original statements or affidavits were furnished. With respect to many of the particulars given by counsel for the Law Society the conduct to be inquired into was very specifically described."

Madera v. Rabi - 1989 BCJ [2204 B.C.C.A.] J.A. Hinkson presiding

(A lack of facts in evidence)

"In the circumstances, the plaintiff [Madera] has not been able... to establish the factual foundation"
